This training series will illustrate preparation activities and strategies to assess an established safety plan. Explore the engagement tools and standards to facilitate deeper information gathering about adult functioning, parenting, and caregiver protective capacities. Identify ways to review and re-evaluate danger threats with the parents/legal guardians to co-construct danger statements, in clear and non-judgmental language. Recognize and develop appropriate case plan actions, tasks, services, and completion dates to achieve desired outcomes. This series will also help to build skills to develop progress updates that evaluate the continued appropriateness of the plan and progress toward case closure. While the focus is on Case Management practice, this series is open to all Child Welfare Professionals and will provide tools to improve engagement and assessment of families and elevate practice across the system.
