Florida's practice model includes the expectation that when children are safe but at high or very high risk for future maltreatment, affirmative outreach and efforts will be provided to engage families in family support services. Family Support services are intended to prevent the occurrence of a future child abuse investigation and/or child maltreatment by:

- Strengthening protective factors that will increase the ability of families to nurture their children successfully.
- Enhancing the social and emotional well-being of each child and the family.
- Enabling families to use other resources and opportunities available in the community.
- Assisting families with creating or strengthening family resource networks to enhance and support childrearing.

This Webinar will provide an understanding of Family Support Services, case type, risk level, utilization of the Family Support Module, documentation including what information should be captured and where this information should this be found in FSFN.
