The Group Care Quality Standards Assessment project is part of an ongoing initiative to enhance the quality of care provided in residential group homes licensed by the Florida Department of Children and Families (Department). The Group Care Quality Standards workgroup created the Core Quality Standards for Residential Group Homes to ensure children receive high-quality, needed services that surpass the minimum thresholds currently assessed through licensing. Following the approval of the Core Quality Standards in 2015, the project moved to the next phase which included the development, piloting, and implementation of a rating scale to assess the Core Quality Standards for Residential Group Care. During this webinar, participants will receive an overview on the background and purpose of the Core Quality Standards for Group Care Initiative. Additionally, information will be shared on the development and piloting of the Group Care Quality Rating Scale.
